

Tasmania's border restrictions have changed from 26th October 2020.

From this date, areas are assessed as either Low, Medium or High risk. The risk level is determined by the number of active COVID-19 cases, and/or levels of community transmission, and/or public health advice.

These border restrictions will change daily so please seek advice from the Tasmanian Department of Health website or call the Public Health Hotline on [1800 671 738](tel:1800671738) . Travellers should advise the hotline that they are in quarantine and have been at one of the identified locations.

TDN staff will continue to ask the question on each scheduled visit whether that is in the home, our Moonah clinic and offices or our Launceston office, as to whether you are well and free of any COVID-19 recognised symptoms and/or if you or a family/visitor have been in an identified risk location and/or are quarantining. We seek your cooperation and those in your household to ensure this information is provided to ensure that TDN staff are safe and other consumers we care for.

The Premier continues to ask all Tasmanians to continue to follow the rules and stay safe. Big thank you to all our TDN community who have followed the rules and assist us in our endeavours to stop the spread of the virus in our beautiful island state.
